Program:

The speaker for today was Staff Sergeant Matthew G. Rubin who has been with the Kansas National Guard for 19 years. SSG Rubin has been with the Drug Abuse Task Force for the Kansas National Guard since 2000.

SSG Rubin reported that random drug screening is given to military personnel. Positive for drug testing on average is 2.49%. There is an 83 item questionnaire given to soldiers returning from deployment. Some soldiers are found to be users of alcohol and some have what is called adrenalin flooding which is based in part on soldiers not receiving breaks or time away for vacation, holiday, etc. Signs and symptoms are usually recognized six months to one year after returning from deployment.

The Kansas National Guard has a Military Family Life Assistance Program too. SSG Rubin will submit a Power Point Presentation via email to Sylvia at CRC to distribute to members of the council for additional information.
